4. Is there sufficient interest in the project by our members?	How many of our members are committed to this project?
5. Are there additional benefits our club will receive as a result of the project? (i.e., increased public awareness/publicity, access to new members or donors)	What are the benefits our club receives as a result?
Step 3: Recommend a Decision Continue, Discontinue, Change, Add, Pilot, or other	Step 4: Provide the rationale that supports the recommendation
